

The City of Long Beach is now accepting applications for the position of Tax Assessor.

Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications of the position which include experience in an occupation involving the valuation of real property such as an assessor, appraiser, valuation data manager, real property and real property appraisal aide. Additionally, strong computer skills, analytical and statistical background, and market trending are essential.

This position is responsible for determining valuations and assessments of real property within the City of Long Beach, for the purpose of ad valorem taxation. This is a Non-Competitive civil service position. If appointed you will be required to have a valid license to operate a motor vehicle within the State of New York or otherwise demonstrate your capacity to meet the transportation needs of the position.

Candidates must have the minimum qualification per the Codes, Rules and Regulations of the State of New York, Title 20, Department of Taxation and Finance, Chapter XVI Real Property Tax Administration Part 8188 and minimum qualification standards, training and certification of local assessment administration personnel, Section 8188-2.2. Additionally candidates must possess the minimum qualifications set by the City of Long Beach Civil Service Commission.
